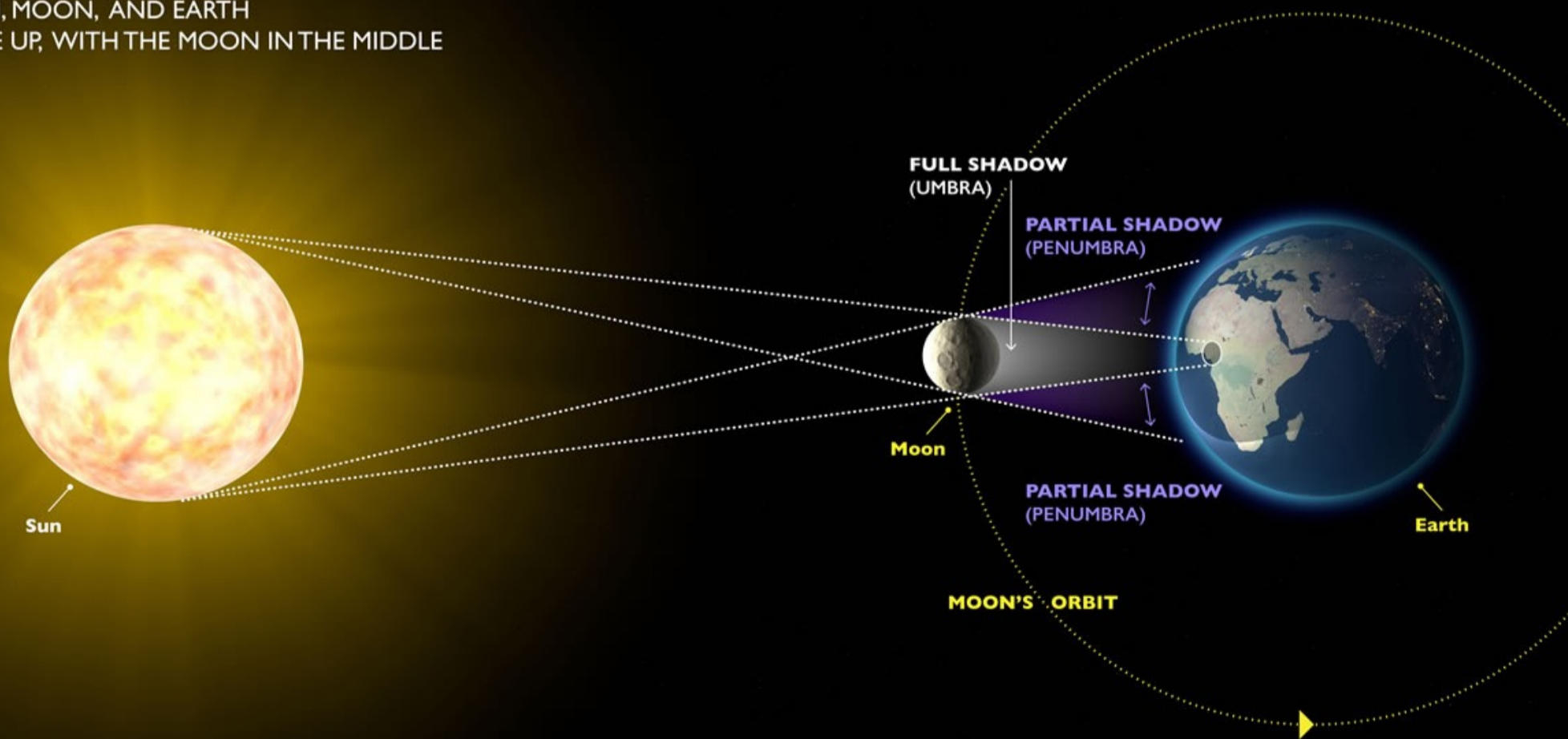
GREAT AMERICAN ECLIPSE

1:23pm - 4:00pm

Join us on the steps of Low Library for a viewing of the partial solar eclipse visible from New York City on Monday, August 21st. The eclipse will begin at 1:23pm and end at 4:00pm, reaching a maximum of ~71% at 2:45pm. There will be solar telescopes set up and a limited number of eclipse glasses will be available.
