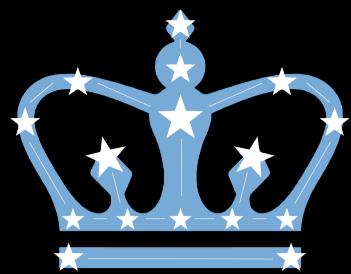


COLUMBIA ASTRONOMY OUTREACH PRESENTS:

Beginning with an astronomy lecture by Andrea Derzinski, the evening will continue upstairs with sound and video art installations in the Astronomy Library and observatory stairwell created by the Amateur Astronomers Society of Voorhees. Our regular stargazing will be available weather permitting.

These are free lectures at a public level followed by guided stargazing with telescopes (weather permitting). All events are held at Pupin Hall at Columbia University. No reservations are needed. Lectures are 30 minutes, stargazing lasts 90 minutes. Stay only as long as you want.
